

LOCAL FAVOURITES AND HIGHLIGHTS

DUBLIN Take an orientation drive to see O'Connell Street, St. Patrick's Cathedral, and Trinity College.

KILDARE Visit the Irish National Stud where thoroughbred horses command respect on the racecourses of the world. En route to Limerick, see the Rock of Cashel where St. Patrick preached.

LIMERICK An orientation drive includes St. Mary's Cathedral, King John's Castle, and the Treaty Stone.

CLIFFS OF MOHER & GALWAY Visit the 668-foot Cliffs of Moher with breathtaking views of the Clare coast. Continue across the glacial-era limestone plateau of The Burren above the Atlantic coast. Enjoy free time to explore the vibrant, medieval city of Galway.

RATHBAUN Visit Rathbaun Farm to try your hand at it scone baking, learn about sheep herding, talk to a farmer, and enjoy coffee and scones at a traditional Irish farm.


ENNIS Take a short drive via Clonderlaw Bay to Killimer; cross the Shannon estuary by ferry.


