

## LOCAL FAVOURITES AND HIGHLIGHTS

**NASHVILLE** Meet your travel companions for a welcome drink. Visit RCA Studio B and enjoy a sightseeing tour of Nashville, Visit the Country Music Hall of Fame to see its collection of costumes, memorabilia and more, Settle into your reserved seats for a show at the Grand Ole Opry.

**MEMPHIS** Visit Sun Studio, where rock 'n' roll was first recorded. Visit the Stax Museum of American Soul Music. Take a guided sightseeing tour of Memphis and travel to Elvis Presley's Graceland for a tour of the King of Rock-n-Roll's estate.

**CLARKSDALE** Follow the Mississippi River into the heart of the Mississippi Delta. Visit the Delta Blues Museum. Enjoy lunch with a local musician at Ground Zero Blues Club.

**NATCHEZ** Dinner at Magnolia Hall Mansion. Guided tour of the Delta Music Museum to hear stories about Jerry Lee Lewis, Mickey Gilley, Conway Twitty, and other famous musicians. Visit Frogmore Cotton Plantation.



**CHARLESTON** Orientation tour of Charleston before a visit to Boone Hall Plantation and Gardens. Enjoy free time to browse the wares of more than 50 artisans at the historic City Market. Ask your Tour Director about the many ways to explore this quintessential Southern city—from cruising on the harbour to the best southern dishes to a ghost tour or stroll along Rainbow Row.

**BEAUFORT** Tour the town by horse-drawn carriage through the narrow, oak lined streets and learn the rich history of the area.

**SAVANNAH** See Savannah in style on a trolley tour with a Local Guide who shares scintillating stories of the city's legendary characters and colourful past. See the southern live oaks draped in Spanish moss where authors have written mysteries and memoirs in Southern flare. Visit the American Prohibition Museum and enjoy a classic cocktail in the speakeasy!

**JEKYLL ISLAND & ST. SIMONS ISLAND** Visit Jekyll Island for a guided trolley tour of the Club Historic District—showcasing 19th-century winter-cottages enjoyed by such families as the Vanderbilts, Rockefellers, and Pulitzers. Enjoy a farewell lunch at the historic Jekyll Island Club. Then, visit nearby St. Simons Island, home to unspoiled beaches, salt marshes, and unjurried Southern charm.
