### LOCAL FAVOURITES AND HIGHLIGHTS

**SEATTLE** Meet your travel companions for a welcome drink. Begin with a tour of the Museum of Flight, the largest independent non-profit air and space museum in the world featuring over 175 air and spacecrafts. Enjoy a guided tour including the Pike Place Market and Pioneer Square. Travel south into Oregon for a visit to Multnomah Falls, the highest waterfall in Oregon, followed by lunch at a local restaurant.

**PORTLAND** Enjoy an orientation tour followed by free time. Discover why Portland is called the "City of Roses" with a visit to Washington Park and the International Rose Test Gardens. Continue through the Willamette Wine Valley to see Yaquina Head, Oregon's tallest lighthouse guiding ships to safety since 1873 before arriving in Newport.

**NEWPORT** Enjoy special dinner at a local restaurant featuring seafood specialties and regional wine. See popular sites such as Heceta Head Lighthouse and Florence Old Town, followed by a dune buggy ride along the Oregon Dunes National Recreation Area.

**NORTH BEND** Travel south to one of Oregon's great natural treasures, the scenic Rogue River. Embark on a jetboat ride. Stop in Redwood National Park, home to the world's tallest trees.

**EUREKA** Make a photo stop at the grand Carson Mansion—the most photographed example of Victorian architecture in the world. Travel to Humboldt Redwoods State Park for the spectacular Avenue of the Giants.

**SAN FRANCISCO** Enjoy a sightseeing tour of San Francisco's most iconic landmarks and sites. Join your Tour Director and travel companions for a special farewell dinner at a local restaurant.

### LOCAL FAVOURITES AND HIGHLIGHTS

**DENVER** Meet your Tour Director and travel companions for a welcome drink. Depart on a scenic drive to the Royal Gorge to ride the rails on the Royal Gorge Route Railroad. Travel to Colorado Springs to explore the ancient red rock formations of Garden of The Gods.

**COLORADO SPRINGS** Depart Colorado Springs and head south into New Mexico, the "Land of Enchantment," to the charming city of Santa Fe. Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant.

**SANTA FE** Visit the Museum of International Folk Art in Santa Fe allows you to explore a vast collection of traditional textiles, ceramics, paintings, and other unique objects that showcase the rich cultural heritage of different regions and communities. Visit nearby Chimayo to visit Santuario De Chimayo and learn about the healing powers that still attract thousands of pilgrims each year. Explore the ancient Anasazi Pueblos, their cliff dwellings, and the museum at Bandelier National Monument. Visit the adobe town of Taos for free time to explore.

**DURANGO** Visit the cliffside dwellings of Mesa Verde National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Enjoy a guided tour of the D&SNG Railway Museum. Board the Durango & Silverton Narrow-Gauge Railroad for a scenic ride through San Juan National Forest.

**GLENWOOD SPRINGS** Travel through the Colorado Rocky Mountains and stay at the historic Hotel Colorado. Take a scenic ride on the Georgetown Loop Railroad.
