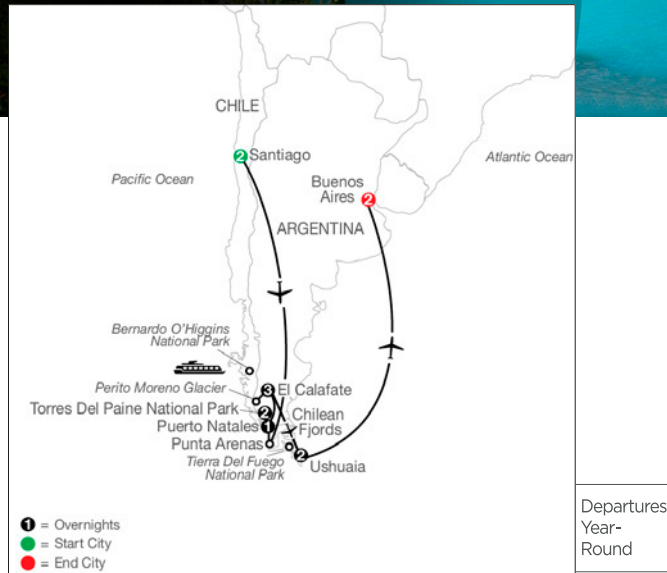

## Patagonia: Journey to the End of the World

TOUR SF 13 Days from Santiago to Buenos Aires



### LOCAL FAVOURITES AND HIGHLIGHTS

**SANTIAGO** Sightseeing includes the Government Palace, Plaza de Armas, the Cathedral, and Santa Lucia Hill. Lunch at a local restaurant and visit La Vega Central Market. Taste a terremoto cocktail at a local pub. Visit Cerro San Cristobal for stunning views of Santiago and the Andes.

**PUNTA ARENAS** Scenic drive through the Patagonian steppe to Puerto Natales.

**PUERTO NATALES** Visit Milódon Cave.

**TORRES DEL PAINE** Scenic drive past waterfalls, icebergs, mountains, rivers, and lakes in Torres del Paine National Park. Sightseeing includes visits to Los Cuernos, Lago Pehoe, Salto Grande, Lago Grey, Grey Glacier, and Laguna Azul. Join a cocktail demonstration and lesson with fresh ingredients from the garden.

**EL CALAFATE** Cruise on Lago Argentino to see icebergs including the 35-mile-long Upsala Glacier. Disembark and visit Estancia Cristina (Cristina Ranch), including a 4-wheel-drive tour or a short hike. Visit Perito Moreno Glacier in Los Glaciares National Park, for a walking tour along the catwalks.

**USHUAIA** Cruise across the Beagle Channel to watch for sea lions, albatrosses, skuas, and other Patagonian fauna. Visit Martillo Island for a chance to see a colony of Magellan penguins.

**TIERRA DEL FUEGO NATIONAL PARK** Sightseeing with a Naturalist includes Bahía Lapataia, Lago Roca, and Bahía Ensenada.

**BUENOS AIRES** Sightseeing with a Local Guide includes Plaza de Mayo to see La Casa Rosada and visit the Metropolitan Cathedral. See Teatro Colón Opera House and visit Recoleta Cemetery, burial site of Eva Perón. Other stops include La Boca and San Telmo. Take a Tango lesson at a famous Tango Club with professional instructors. Farewell Argentine steak dinner, followed by a Tango show.

## Costa Rica: Coast to Coast

### LOCAL FAVOURITES AND HIGHLIGHTS

**SAN JOSÉ** Drive through tropical mangroves en route to Guacalillo for a cruise on Tárcoles River in search of crocodiles, nesting birds, and more.

**MANUEL ANTONIO NATIONAL PARK AREA** Join a Naturalist Guide in Manuel Antonio National Park for a guided hike to search for sloths, toucans, monkeys, and more. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant. Free time to enjoy the beach and resort.

**ARENAL** Guided visit to Arenal Hanging Bridges. Visit Eco Termales Hot Springs for a dip in the pools before dinner at the hot springs. Guided visit to Arenal Volcano National Park includes lava trails and nature that has recovered from past lava flows. Walking tour of the town of La Fortuna de San Carlos includes spectacular views of the active Arenal Volcano.

**GUANACASTE** Journey from Arenal, descending the Tilarán Mountains through countryside plains to the golden sands of Tamarindo Beach. Ample free time to enjoy the resort, beach, or optional adventures. Farewell dinner.
